WHO SHOULD APPLY FOR THIS COURSE?

Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care is a course for those who are:

- Seeking to work in the early childhood education and care industry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Whilst there are no formal entry requirements stipulated in the training package (CHC), EduNex requires its applicants to:

- be over 18 years' of age
- have completed Year 11 or equivalent
- meet ONE the following English proficiency requirements of this course:
 - evidence of holding IELTS band score of overall 6 (Academic) or equivalent or;
 - be able to provide any of the following evidence of English Language competence
 - that they were educated for 5 years in an English-speaking country.
 - that they have successfully completed their Year 11 or equivalent in English Language or;
 - Certificate IV or higher completed in Australia

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Students ave the required level of Language, Learning and Numeracy skills required by the course by completing a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment conducted by an EduNex Training at the time of orientation to identify the support required by the students.

IT

Work Placement
